Aims to row the Atlantic

Chestertown native Terence Steinberg — an elementary classmate of mine many years ago at St. Mary's-St. Alphonsus school in Glens Falls — has run 43 marathons, several Ironman races and a 145-mile ultra marathon that took 35 hours to finish — no sleep, all running.

Chestertown native Terence Steinberg plans 3,000 mile voyage

Now he aims to row across the Atlantic Ocean — west to east, Christopher Columbus's 3,000 mile route following the trade winds from the Canary Islands off Morocco to Antiqua in the Caribbean — next January through April.

Now 32, Terence is a business consultant in Boulder, Colorado. "I haven't rowed more than five

miles before," he told *The Chronicle* by phone.

"You don't need to be an expert at this stuff to do something crazy. What I really want to do with this is to inspire people to trust

themselves to do something that they have no evidence to expect that they can do.

"The truth is we can hop a lot farther than we think we can. I

The loss of Joe Turcotte

"Joe was the smartest, gentlest, kindest person I know," said Amy Turcotte, at her husband Joe Turcotte's funeral on Thursday, Oct. 3, at the Parish of St. Isaac Jogues in Chestertown.

Mr. Turcotte, 38, of Brant Lake, was killed on Sept. 26 when the truck he was driving on the I-87 Exit 25 exit ramp was hit from behind by a vehicle whose driver was fleeing police.

More than 250 mourners filled the small Catholic church as friends and family shared stories of his life. Boxes of tissues were shared in the aisles. Tears flowed.

Amy said that after Joe graduated from Cornell University, he

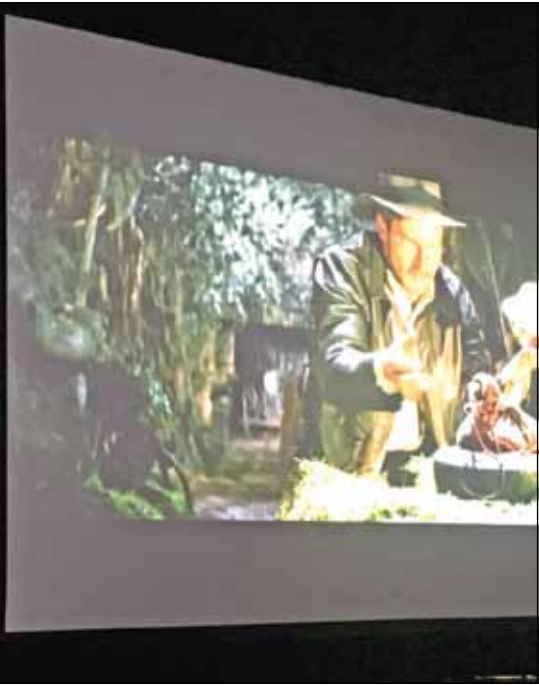
